WHAT WE LEARNED

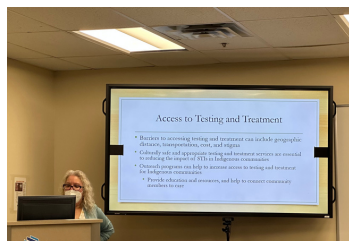
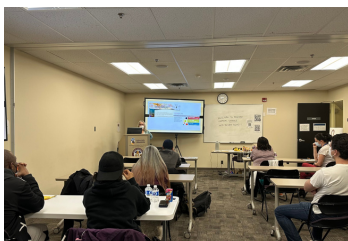
We learned about racism and discrimination in health care, antiracist, decolonial and inclusive approaches in health care, and culturally safe health care.
